of our members to attain a high level in competitions. Fencing is composed of three disciplines; foil, épée and sabre. The club lessons are essentially for learning and handling the sabre. All are welcome to the club, from toddler fencing (Age 4) to adults.



Artistic fencing is a modern sport reconstructing and applying fencing of a bygone age in contemporary artistic representations.

Our association provides the possibility to practice artistic fencing every Tuesday as well as beginners or perfection courses for duelling for representations of the Middle Ages and the renaissance period.



The Agua Ferro troop concentrates on the authenticity of the representation of their fencing scenes, with research on the costumes, weapons, and the combat techniques... giving the closest representation of our ancestors' fencing.

Musketeer fencing, or 17th century duelling, medieval combats, shows and jokers, technical demonstrations, each year the Agua Ferro Fencing troop prepares new fencing scenes. These scenes will take you to the heart of the burlesque tales of old, where humour, duelling and dialogue create an unforgettable atmosphere.

and pyrotechnics are performed solo, in duos and trios accompanied by music and circus acts.




